# FOR VOTERS IN CENTRAL COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT #4

Shall members of the Board of Education of Central Community Unit School District No. 4, Iroquois and Kankakee Counties, Illinois, be elected in 2027 and thereafter, at large and without restriction by area of residence within the district instead of the current restriction that not more than three (3) members of the board of education may be selected from one (1) congressional township in the school district?

# FOR VOTERS IN THE MOMENCE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Greater Momence Fire Protection District, Kankakee County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to 0.40% above the limiting rate for fire protection and ambulance purposes for levy year 2023 and be equal to 0.6615% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2025?

- (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recent extended limiting rate is \$434,978.85, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$1,100,338.
- (2) For the 2025 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$133.33.
- (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2025 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).



# Need to register to vote or update your registration after moving or changing your name?

Grace Period Registration is available now through Election Day, at the Kankakee County Clerk's office.

You will be required to vote at the time you update your registration.

#### To register to vote, you must be:

- 1. A U.S. Citizen.
- 2. At least 18 years of age by Election Day.
- 3. A resident of your precinct at least 30 days prior to election day.

In order to register, you must provide two forms of identification, one of which must include your current address. Acceptable forms of identification include:

- Illinois driver's license/ID Card
- Social Security card
- Valid U.S. Passport

- Employee or student ID
- Birth certificate
- Public Aid ID Card

- Credit Card
- Utility bill in applicant's name
- Lease or rental contract
